In the event of inclement weather, the event will be held in the Tiger Den Suites.

We want to take this opportunity to establish an active relationship with the corporate and tennis communities of Louisiana. We are looking to build a partnership to ensure a promising future for LSU tennis in an increasingly competitive environment.

In order to continue attracting top college level athletes, we need to upgrade our facilities to be competitive by SEC and National standards. The SEC has become the premier conference in college tennis. Many of the SEC schools' facilities have been improved or new stadiums created to reflect their national standing.

The premiere college tennis programs in combination with corporate and private donors have invested heavily in new indoor facilities and revitalized their outdoor stadiums. New indoor facilities eliminate the effects of inclement weather on practice, matches and tournaments. The indoor courts provide comfortable viewing year round to supporters. Good indoor courts coupled with modernization of existing outdoor facilities creates an opportunity to host National and Regional championships.

In 1970, W. T. "Dub" Robinson Stadium was opened as a state of the art tennis facility. Since then we have succeeded in adding 4 SEC championships, 1 NCAA Final and 2 NCAA Final Four appearances.

We hope that you will join us now as a long-term partner in the future of LSU Tennis. Your involvement can help provide LSU with a premiere tennis facility and support the LSU Tigers in their quest to be a leader in collegiate tennis.
